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FEMA COVID DEATH FUNERAL ASSISTANCE

Who can apply for COVID-19 Funeral Assistance?

- you are a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified non-citizen.
- the death occurred in the United States, including U.S. territories and the District of Columbia;
- the death was attributed to COVID-19; and
- you are responsible for the eligible funeral expenses incurred on or after January 20, 2020

What FEMA will cover?

Funeral Services; Cremation; Interment; Transportation for up to two people to identify the who died; Marker or Headstone; Clergy; Funeral Ceremony; Costs associated with producing death certificates; Casket or Urn; Funeral home equipment or staff; Burial Plot; Costs due to local or state government laws or ordinances.

What assistance is being offered?

Assistance is limited to \$9000 for funeral services, interment, and cremation expenses. To be approved for reimbursement of funeral expenses due to a COVID-19 fatality, you must have incurred funeral expenses for the deceased individual and have documentation (receipts, funeral home contracts, etc.) showing your name as the responsive party.
